ADDED VALUE: The FERMI training methodology, along with tools and curricula to be developed for Law Enforcement Agencies (LEAs) in the FERMI project, will increase the understanding of the trainees regarding additional capabilities and technologies offered by the FERMI platform. This includes its future potential, such as identifying disinformation spreading and assessing potential impact on security and safety.

The preliminary plan involves FERMI collaborating with CEPOL (The European Union Agency for Law Enforcement Training) to integrate the online training into CEPOL's eLearning platform, LEEd.



This collaboration could potentially extend the opportunity to share the training with the broader network of LEA partners in the future.

PRIVACY & ETHICS

CEPOL maintain the personal registry on their server, collecting data solely for participant verification to ensure access to the LEEd platform.
